Orange Summer | new

- A unique, early maturing hybrid Uchiki Kuri type.
- Vigorous bush variety that produces uniform and highly attractive fruit.
- Fruit are round, each weighing 1.0-1.6 kg depending on production conditions and plant population.
- Its smooth, orange-red skin and bright yellow flesh are ideal for processing.
- The creamy, delicious flesh is best for fresh consumption, cooking and steaming.
- Orange Summer produces on average 1.5-2.0 fruit per plant but yields of 2.5 fruit per plant are achievable.
- Ideal plant populations under irrigation varies from 6.000-10.000 plants per hectare.
- Fruit are a sought after product.



Iron Lady

- Hybrid grey pumpkin; vine type with good vigour.
- Produces medium to large sized fruit that fit the South African requirements perfectly.
- Maintains its grey fruit colour very well in storage and does not show orange discoloration.
- Small seed cavity, orange fruit colour and fine texture provide an excellent quality fresh cut product.
- The plant holds up significantly better in the field against general disease pressure.
- Resistance: IR: ZYMV/WMV/PRSV

Winston

- Earlier maturing hybrid grey pumpkin; semi-bush type.
- Yields medium to large sized fruit of 4-6 kg.
- Fruit are flat-round and only slightly ribbed.
- Winston is well-suited for both the fresh market and processing.
- Uniform, mid-grey fruit does very well in storage and it has no problems with orange skin discoloration.
- Resistance: IR: ZYMV/WMV/PRSV
